He began his career with Game and Fish as a hunting safety training officer in 1978, and was named chief of the information and education division in 1987. Along the way, he has earned the Game and Fish Employee of the Year Award twice.

Steve is the host and co-producer of "Talkin' Outdoors at the Corner Café," a 30-minute, weekly television program.

Born in 1950, Steve grew up in southwest Little Rock. He holds a bachelor's degree in speech, business administration and education from Southern Nazarene University in Bethany, Okla., and a master's degree in business administration from the University of Central Oklahoma in Edmond.
